

#### WORLD DIABETES DAY.

World Diabetes Day is celebrated on the birthday of Sir Frederick Banting, who co-discovered insulin along with Charles Best in 1922. *Lion Carol Browne* met with staff from the *Open Door Crisis Centre* to have a discussion on "Understanding Diabetes".

The aim was to give them knowledge to be able to motivate people they meet with diabetes, so as to encourage them to manage their health. People with diabetes should not have to 'suffer' from it.

Modern medication and lifestyle adaptation make it possible for people with diabetes to lead full and productive lives. However failure to manage the condition results in fluctuating blood sugar levels, and this can result in compilations such as loss of sight, kidney failure or amputation of limbs, due to gangrene. People with diabetes are more prone to infectious diseases including TB and Covid.

People at risk of developing diabetes include those with family history of diabetes, people who are overweight, who have poor eating patterns and who are not physically active. The lifestyle to prevent or delay the onset of diabetes is the same as the one to treat it. It is better to start healthy practices sooner, rather than wait for complications to develop.

The illustration attached shows how insulin acts as the key to open cell doors, so that sugar can move from the blood stream to the cells, to provide energy. Understanding the physiology of the condition helps people to understand management of diabetes through lifestyle and medication.




