

The <u>Alberton Lions club</u> recently celebrated their 50th Anniversary and induction of their 51st Lion President, Tammy du Plooy.



LP Natalie Laas (*Right*) was inducted as president and 8 members were inducted into the club. We wish them all the best for the rest of the year as they make a difference with in their community.








