MEET LIONS INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT BRIAN SHEEHAN

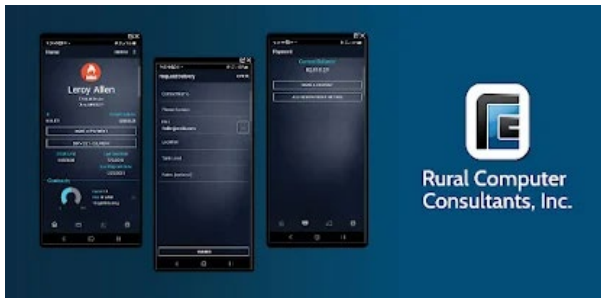

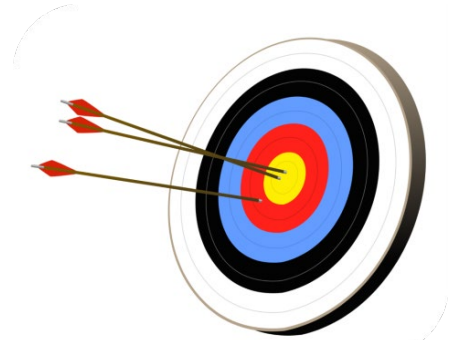

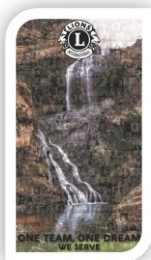
CLOSURE OF THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR

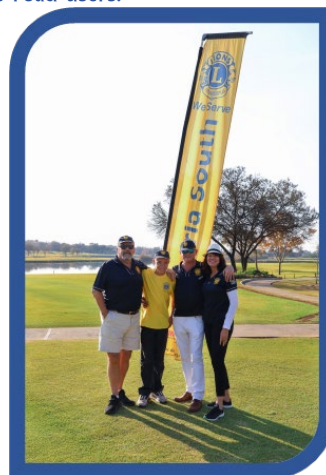
The 18th of July (Mandela Day) had the Lions of Pretoria South hard at work uplifting the community in Mamelodi by planting trees and painting walkways.

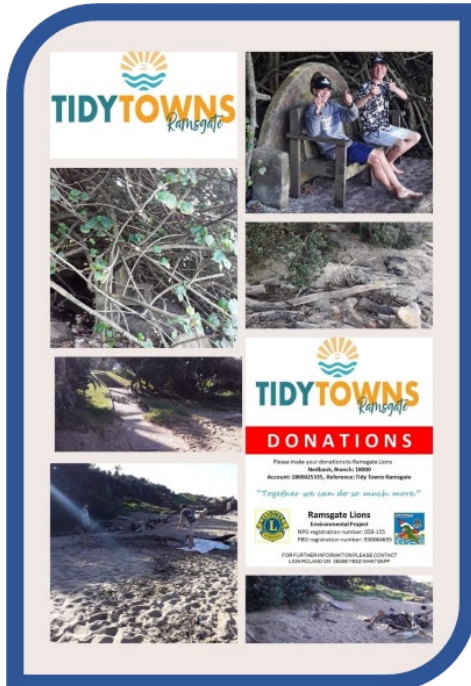

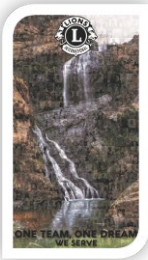

One of the deliveries was 67 Jars of Hope, Beans and Scarves to CLAW. These were distributed to families living in the informal areas around CLAW.



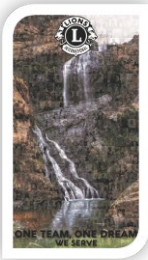
